MINUTES

April 12, 2006 Whetten Graduate Center -- Giolas Conference Room 2:30 P.M.

- 1. The meeting was called to order at 2:36 P.M. Interim Vice Provost Gregory J. Anderson presided.
- 2. It was **moved**, seconded, and **passed** without dissent on a voice vote to approve as distributed the minutes of the 3/1/06 meeting.
- 3. It was **moved**, seconded, and **passed** without dissent on a voice vote to approve with one minor correction the list of Plans of Study and Dissertation Proposals.
- 4. It was **moved**, seconded, and **passed** without dissent on a voice vote to approve the Satisfactory/Unsatisfactory (S/U) grading option for PT 461, PT 464, PT 467, and PT 468.
- 5. G. Anderson updated the group on the work of the Special Fellowship Committee.
- 6. J. Henkel spoke about the need for units to develop Diversity Plans. He asked members to provide input concerning elements to include in a proposal for a plan for Research and Graduate Education. There was considerable discussion.
- 7. A proposal received from the School of Nursing to establish Post-Master Certificate Tracks in Nursing was introduced for consideration. J. Henkel noted that the proposed tracks are intended to provide retraining opportunities for practicing nurses.
 - Following discussion, it was **moved** (E. Smith), seconded, and **passed** without dissent on a voice vote to approve the Certificate Tracks in Adult Acute Care, Adult Primary Care, Community Health Nursing, Neonatal Acute Care, Patient Care Services and Systems Administration, and Psychiatric Mental Health.
- 8. J. Henkel introduced a new Graduate School course -- *GRAD 310 Responsible Conduct in Research* -- for consideration and approval. It was **moved** (E. Smith), seconded (D. Cournoyer), and **passed** without dissent on a voice vote to approve the course as presented.
- 9. Following a brief discussion about meeting agendas, it was agreed that posting agendas and attachments to a secure Web site would be an effective means of disseminating meeting materials in the future. Until a secure Web site can be implemented, it was agreed that agendas and attachments will continue to be distributed via e-mail with the understanding that the Graduate School will provide hard copies at each meeting (obviating the need for members to print their own personal copies).
- 10. It was agreed to call a meeting of the Graduate Faculty Council for Wednesday, April 19, 2006.
- 11. There were several announcements and updates.
- 12. Adjournment was at 3:50 PM.
